It has been a while, so here is an update from us again. The last weeks have been really busy for us, so it is high time to share everything that has been going on. We hope you are safe and healthy in this time of Covid-19. We thank God that despite the virus hindering us in some work, we still managed to do a lot of other things which we will share in this newsletter.



First of all, maybe you noticed a logo on the top of the newsletter. We are very happy to present our logo that has been created for the organization.

As a ministry we want to make a change in this world, and we invite people to be a part of this change. We wanted a logo that reflects this idea and to show that our foundation is in the Bible. The logo will help us to make our organization more visible to others and so we are delighted that we can now use it.

Furthermore, our piggery project is still running. In the last newsletter we shared that we brought a male pig to the project. We are still confirming, but we think that our female pig is pregnant! We are really excited that if the pregnancy goes well, soon we will have piglets so that the project can expand, and we can start giving out piglets to the youth. As we still had some space on the land, we decided to plant some banana trees and to take care of the trees that were already there when we purchased the land. We see that more and more people are willing to be part of the organization and help us out in practical ways such as planting and weeding. We are very grateful for that.



Besides the piggery project, we decided to start with a new project. A lot of Ugandan girls are struggling to access sanitary pads for their period each month. This causes them to drop out of school or to stay at home for those days.

Often girls end up choosing the wrong path in order to get those basic needs. Many girls start having boyfriends that can provide them with some money to buy pads. This can lead to early pregnancies and even diseases. We would like to hand out sanitary pads to these vulnerable young ladies to prevent them from messing up because of these basic needs.



Because of this, we started raising funds for this project so that we can hand out pads to those ladies in the communities that need it most. We created a GoFundMe page and the first donations have been coming in. We trust God for more funds so that we can reach more girls.

Lastly, we as the five founders have also been busy with outlining a constitution. We believe that it is good to plan for the future and to write things down on paper so that there won't be confusion. Several times a week we are having meetings to discuss about certain aspects of the constitution. We are seeing that God shows us what to focus on and what He calls us to do. There are so many needs in Uganda, but we realize that there are certain tasks that God entrusts to us and we believe that the other things will be taken care of by others. Thank you for standing by our side in everything that we do. We pray for your safety and health in this time of Corona and wish you a good week.
