In the midst of all the news about COVID-19, here an update from our organisation in this turbulent time. We hope you, your family and friends are doing well. We are praying that the Lord will keep on protecting you. In this newsletter we will share about the school ministry that we did and our piggery project in Kalungami village.



On the 4<sup>th</sup> of March we were able to do school ministry for the children of Joy Primary school in Wairaka, Jinja, Uganda. It was hosted in Abundant Life Church and one of our members, Brian, shared on the scripture in Proverbs 3:5-6 "*Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight*". Our prayer for the children is that as they grow up in this world full of

temptations, that they will put their trust in the Lord. Also, we as an organisation desire to submit everything to God. We try to do things not by our own understanding but by God's guidance. We were blessed to have this opportunity to share with the children. Despite this, we did feel like we need to focus on youths in particular. So, from now on, we decided to put our focus on ministries concerning youths.

Last month we have been busy with setting up our first project for the youths. In February we managed to buy land in Kalungami village. We prayed and decided to start with a piggery project. So, in March we built a house for the pigs and we managed to buy the first pig for the ministry. The building process went well. The community in the village helped us out greatly. They were willing to sell poles to us and they also helped in building the piggery house. We are excited to see that already in the starting phase of the project the wider community, and youths in specifically, were willing to help out.

We hope this will continue so that we will be able to build a relationship with them and in that way share about our faith with them. After finishing the piggery house, we started looking for a pig. Eventually we found a good pig and we took it to our land.

Right now, the project is taken care of by some members of the community. They help us out by collecting food for the pig, feeding it and cleaning its house.

They also helped out in weeding and organizing the compound. We thank God that He provided us with people that are willing to help us out in this time as it is difficult for us to visit the site daily because of the Corona virus. In Uganda currently means of transport are not available. This means that everything needs to be done footing. Luckily Kalungami village is a walkable distance so we can continue keeping watch of the project.



In the coming weeks we will thus keep on taking care of our pig. Several times a week we check on the project to see whether it is still running well. As the pig is ready to become pregnant, last week we brought a male pig. We hope that soon the pig will be pregnant so that the project will expand, and we will be able to give out piglets to the youth. We would also love to buy other pigs, but we are still waiting for funds. We trust God that He will bless the ministry, as we believe in His faithfulness. Thank you for your prayers and your involvement. May God bless you!
