A few weeks have already passed again so here an update from us. Lately we have been busy with preparing a conference that we held on the 23rd of November. The theme of the conference was "We are the Light of the World" - let us live as examples to others. In this newsletter we will tell about the conference and our next steps.



In the weeks leading to the conference we have been busy with getting a venue, speakers and musicians to help us with the praise and worship. We are very grateful for all the people that were willing to help us with the conference. We had a lot of volunteers that helped us out one way or another by cooking, cleaning or singing for example. With all this, we were able to host a conference in the Trinity Methodist Church in Wanyange, Jinja for more than 100 youth.



We started the conference with prayer and intercession. After that we told the youth what our organization stands for and what our vision and mission are, followed by praise and worship. Then Suli came with his team. Suli is part of the evangelism team of YWAM Hope Land and is from Tonga Island. He came with members from the evangelism team, some family members and a speaker from New Zealand,

named Michael. It was a great morning in which several members of this team sang some special songs, did some dances and shared powerful words with the youth. Michael was our first main speaker. He used scriptures to encourage the youth to be a light in this world. He stressed that the eyes are like a lamp for the body, so that the youth need to use their eyes well so that they can be a shining light. A condition for us to move in the light is that we accept Jesus.

The morning went by so quickly, so it was already time for lunch. Some of our friends helped us with cooking rice, meat and matooke. This was a great time of sharing with each other.



We continued the program with praise and worship, after which our second guest speaker, Immaculate from YWAM Discovery Centre, shared with the youth. It was a great afternoon in which Immaculate shared a lot of Biblical truth with the youth. She told the youth that they need to shine their light before people so that they will see good things in them and that will bring those other people closer to God. She explained how important it is for us to be lights in our community also for non-believers around us. At 16:30 the youth were still enjoying, but the conference needed to be concluded. We again got a lot of positive feedback from the youth and the wider community. We see that several youths are attending all our activities and want us to share more with them. So, we desire to continue organizing activities to encourage the youth in our community.



In December, however, we are planning to focus on fundraising as we need income before we can organize events again. Also, in the coming month we will keep on praying about which activities to organize. Of course, we will still be available for the youth to mentor them. We hope that we will be able to get funds so that in January we will be able to organize some activities again, as we really see the need for the youth to hear God's truth in the middle of so much brokenness.
